Chinese New Year battle of the chefs

WHAT: 2012 Sydney Chinese New Year Festival Ambassador and *MasterChef Australia* 2010 winner **Adam Liaw** and **Wenfu Zeng** from legendary Chinese restaurant chain Tanyoto will compete in an explosive cook-off live on stage **TOMORROW** as part of the City of Sydney's Year of the Dragon celebrations.

The cook-off will see Liaw and Zeng from Chengdu, China's most famous foodie city, battle the clock to deliver delicious Chinese New Year specialties. In just 10 minutes, Liaw will prepare Raw Lobster Yee Sang, a traditional Chinese New Year dish, while Zeng will showcase Hot and Sour Sweet Potato Vermicelli, a Tanyoto signature dish.
